

Leading Causes of Kitchen Fires.

Stove/Oven Temperature Too High

Cooking Oil Level Too High in Pan


Unattended Stove/Oven

Effective Kitchen Fire Prevention Plan.

Appropriate Clothing.

Lid or Cookie Sheet to Cover Fire. Extinguisher.

Reminder Prop (Spoon, Towel, etc.)



Develop Correct Response Measures.

DON'T PANIC!

Cover and Smother Flaming Pans. Do NOT use water on Flammable Liquids. Turn off Stove, Allow to Cool Before Cleanup. Leave Oven Doors Closed. Turn Off. If Clothing Ignites...Stop, Drop and Roll! QUESTIONS????
