DHS, TCAD, and the AAAD's saw the extensive need for Older Adult specific outreach and application assistance.

In Tennessee, there are a large percentage of older adults who are eligible for SNAP and either not getting it, or not getting the maximum benefit for which they are entitled.

East Tennessee had the largest prevalence of unused SNAP eligibility in the state, so we started this pilot grant project here, in collaboration with First Tennessee AAAD and East Tennessee Human Resource Agency AAAD.

Grant Basics

- TCAD Provides some oversight, report writing and invoicing
- 100% Pass- through
- SNAP Outreach Grant is a 50/50 Match Grant
- Requires very specific program reports, contact spreadsheets, and invoices monthly
- Outreach goals are set in the yearly outreach plan

Accomplishments for both agencies: February 15– September 30, 2017 (7 ¹/₂ months)

- so SNAP Screenings 2,705
- So Application Assistance 426
- so SNAP Events 150 events
- So Materials Distributed 16,662 Fliers

In Project Year 2018, we have proposed to include the entire state in the project.

Currently awaiting final approval to start

Initial project took mid-way though year to get started
